Daniel,

I've briefly looked over the work plan and it appears acceptable, but when they submit the final report to support the basin plan amendment, it will need to be stand-alone and include the groundwater data used (not just referencing the GAR), it will need to be more detailed spatially in the different depths of the de-designation zone (e.g. identifying areas where it will extend to the A Clay, where it extends to the C Clay, the Corcoran Clay and the mid-Tulare Clay) and it shouldn't include areas where TDS is less than 3,000 mg/L, as it currently does (along the proposed western and eastern boundaries). Also, more than likely they will need a monitoring program down-gradient from the de-designation area (e.g. in the south-east, in the direction of the plunging anticline) to show the de-designation area isn't affecting beneficial uses down-gradient, since unlike the Tulare Lakebed De-designation area, groundwater continues to flow away from the proposed de-designation area in certain directions. This monitoring could be part of their Groundwater Quality Trend Monitoring program for the ILRP.
