

CV-SALTS Technical Project Manager Procurement

Ad-Hoc Selection Committee Recommendation

The Ad-Hoc TPM Selection Committee released a request for qualifications and technical project manager proposal request on June 30, 2011. The purpose of the Request for Qualifications identified that it was the intention to contract with one or more firms for services to support CV-SALTS. The Ad-Hoc Committee reviewed the four proposals received and selected three teams to interview on August 1, 2011. The Ad-Hoc Committee thanks all responding teams and prime contract firms: CDM, Erler and Kalinowski, Inc., Larry Walker and Associates, and Stantec.

After the interviews the Ad-Hoc Committee found several teams had excellent qualifications for elements to respond to the technical management and technical study challenges of CV-SALTS. The Ad-Hoc Committee determined that a combination of firms will best serve CV-SALTS needs.

The Ad-Hoc Committee is recommending both technical project manager and technical services providers for procurement. Erler and Kalinowski, Inc. or EKI is recommended as the Technical Project Manager. The Ad-Hoc Committee recommends the Executive committee approve contracting with EKI for TPM services according to their proposed scope of work for one year with two one year optional renewals for a not to exceed cost of \$400,000.

Further the Ad-Hoc Committee recommends the Executive Committee authorize a contract with CDM for special Basin Planning Assistance to the TPM team. Additionally the Ad-Hoc Committee is recommending that the Executive Committee authorize the Ad-Hoc Committee to work with the technical project manager and program manager to identify highly qualified respondents to support specific technical elements of CV-SALTS work. The Ad-Hoc Committee recommendations would be provided to the Executive Committee by October 2011.
