### Discussion Items

#### Item 1: Welcome & Introductions

#### Item 2: Approval of Minutes of the March 17, 2020 Meeting Notes

- The approval of the March 17, 2020 Meeting Action Notes was deferred until the May 12<sup>th</sup> meeting, pending revision of the notes to include more detail on the discussion of expansion of outreach materials in support of dischargers who have a choice regarding whether to participate in a Management Zone.

#### Item 3: Outreach Matrix Update

- Charles Gardiner provided a status update on the matrix, press and broader outreach. There is now a total of three years of outreach activities documented in the matrix.
  - Although in-person meeting schedules have been reduced, Charles reminded the committee that the distribution of any outreach materials should also be documented in the matrix.

#### Item 4: Support for Management Zones

- Update on timeline for mailout of NTCs
  - Per Anne Walters, there has been no change to the 60-day extension status.
- Workshops – Charles Gardiner presented a draft outline of the consultants webinar presentation, [Nitrate and Salt Permitting Improvements Coming for the Central Valley](#).
  - Committee members were asked to review the draft and provide input on content areas which need expanding, or ones that may still need to be incorporated.
    - Webinar issues still to be decided: WHEN to hold the webinar, WHO to invite, and HOW to invite the target audience.
    - Comments should be forwarded to Charles Gardiner no later than Friday, May 8<sup>th</sup>.
- Links to new Pathway A Materials now on website – Based on issues raised at the March 17<sup>th</sup> PEOC meeting, and further discussed at the March Management Zone Support meeting, three new documents on Pathway A have been added to the website. Links to the documents we provided in the [agenda package](#). CVRWQCB Staff is also working on a guidance document for Pathway A.
- An issue was raised regarding the need for potential coordination with the assessment and data gathering work being done under SB200. Walt Plachta indicated that Regional Board Staff had talked with the SB200 group regarding the interface with the CV-Salts work. He will forward any pertinent files. Anne Walters advised there were different methodologies and assumptions being used in the SB200 models.

#### Item 5: Choosing Pathway A

#### Item 6: Salt Control Program

- Per Daniel Cozad there is no need for additional materials currently. The P&O web portal for payment of fees is currently in development, and once launched there may be need for additional materials to guide users through that payment process.
