Discussion Items

Item 1: Welcome & Introductions

Item 2: Approval of Minutes of the September 15, 2020 Meeting Notes

- The September 15, 2020 Meeting Action Notes were approved by consensus. There were no objections.

Item 4: Support for Management Zones

- Charles Gardiner presented the [Fall email program update](#). Committee members were asked to review the draft update and provide comments to Charles. The committee expressed concern with the update specifying the notices to comply for the Salt Control program would be out in November. Charles will revise the update with a more generalized timeframe.
- Management Zones have expressed a need for Spanish translations of the “[New Nitrate Control Program](#)” 4-page brochure, and the “[Nitrate Control Program Overview](#)” web page with Q&A drop down. Charles will contact translation services, and these documents will be made available on the cvsalinity.org website.

Item 5: Salt Control Program

- The committee discussed the draft Salt Control Fact Sheet. Some of the feedback from the committee on the Salt Control Program Fees by Permit Type table:
 - Clarify the ILRP Action Required wording by inserting “collecting and” after “Your coalition is...”
 - List the coalitions who are NOT participating in the collection & payment of fees.
 - Make clear the distinction between dairies and cattle facilities that are regulated under the bovine program.
 - Charles will mark the fact sheet as draft, and work with Daniel to confirm the final resolution for the various permit types under Action Required/Annual Fee in the table. The revised fact sheet will be presented to the Executive Committee on 10/22 for review and comment.
- The webinar scheduling is on hold until the mail date for the Notices to Comply is confirmed. The mailing of Notices to Comply for the Salt Control Program is still pending USEPA approval.
