2019-2020

In May 2019 the CVSC Board of Directors approved Resolution 1004. This resolution sets the guidelines and rules for the fee system to be used to fund the Prioritization and Optimization (P&O) Study. Resolution 1004 sets forward in policy the basis for industry or permit type shares shown in Table A attached. Each industry or permit type has somewhat different allocation to permittees or participants in their programs which were proposed by the industry's representatives and approved by the Board. These fees are shown in Table B. The CVSC Board will review these fees and allocations annually and may change the allocations or fees for future years.
