We were disappointed that a lot of the language we added to the previous version of the Secondary MCL policy, in which we were trying to clarify the importance of secondary MCLs, was not accepted. We are not resubmitting those comments since we expect they would be rejected again.

We request more time to consider and comment on the Secondary MCL Policy after the CEQA and Antidegradation analyses are available because it is extremely important to us to understand how this policy affects surface water, particularly at the Delta drinking water intakes of CUWA's members. As you know, there is just a placeholder in the Secondary MCL Policy that states that the language will be taken from the Antidegradation analysis. Do you know when those documents will be available for review?
