First Call for Papers

Papers that address salinity-related work along the lines of the topics listed below that will be relevant for presentation in a scientific/policy conference are sought. Papers can be based on lab experiments, field experiments, case studies, modeling approaches, field-level, basin-level, regional-level.

The conference will have two venues of presentation: (1) paper session and (2) poster sessions. Papers can be a-priori submitted for consideration in a poster session. Papers can also be submitted for consideration in a paper session. However, the advisory committee may offer the author to present in a poster session.

RELEVANT TOPICS:

- Social and economic impacts of salinization
- Sustainable soil management under irrigation with saline waters
- Salt tolerance of crop and pasture species
- Regional watershed and basin management strategies for salinity control
- Wildlife impacts related to salinization
- Mapping and monitoring salinity at regional and field scales
- Development of plants with improved salt tolerance
- Treated sewage water reuse and disposal
- Old places same problems?
- Conjunctive use of surface water, ground water, recycled drainage water
